AVA/2014/0817 Land off Heanor Road
Full planning application for the erection of 101 dwellings, associated infrastructure, access and public open space

RESOLVED: Members agreed to object to the above planning application for the following reasons;

- ***The 101 houses will create additional traffic which will be using the junction at Adale Road.***

- *The A608 is a very busy road particularly early morning and evening the additional houses are going to create at the very least 200 more cars exiting the development at Adale Road per day.*
- *The junction is on a hill with limited visibility, vehicles turning right towards Heanor can take a significant amount of time to be able to exit this junction, serious consideration should be given to the road safety when looking at this planning application*

a) Dobholes Lane Recreation Ground – Accident

Clerk reported she had received an email regarding a child who has had an accident on the play equipment on Dobholes Lane, Clerk to write to Mrs Tate confirming the play equipment is all up to British standards and regularly checked.

b) Dobholes Lane Recreation Ground – Barrier

Quotation received from S Clarke for the barrier on Dobholes Lane Recreation Ground, Clerk to obtain 2 more quotations.

c) Muga Fencing

A quotation has been received from Sutcliffe regarding the additional fencing around the MUGA. Clerk to obtain 2 more quotations.

d) Planning Permission

Amber Valley have granted permission for the car park on Dobholes Lane Recreation Ground.

RESOLVED: Members agreed that the Clerk should send an order no to contractor, who should be able to complete the work fairly quickly.

e) Closure of footpath

Clerk advised that whilst the work is being carried out on Dobholes Lane Recreation Ground the footpath should be closed, members agreed that as the work would not take long they would not apply for closure.

f) Section 106 funding

Section 106 funding has been approved for the car park and entrance to Stainsby Meadow recreation ground.
