**88/14 Report of the Parish Clerk**

**a) Dobholes Lane Recreation Ground**

Cllr Roger's expressed his concern over the workmanship of Sutcliffe Play Groundwork's team.

**RESOLVED:** Clerk to pay the remainder of the outstanding account to Sutcliffe's.

It was noted that the opening of the Dobholes Lane Recreation Ground was a successful event.

**b) Muga Fencing**

**RESOLVED:** Clerk to obtain a quotation for the installation of fencing around the sides of the MUGA. Also find out what sizes are available.

**RESOLVED:** Football fees are to be increased to £30 for each match played on the recreation ground.
